

Class Description: Students will have choices of what to draw based on their skill levels and interests. **Grades K-12.** Options are subject to change but may include:

- ⇒ Drawing and Shading with Pencils
- ⇒ Colored Pencils
- ⇒ Watercolor Markers – turn markers into paint
- ⇒ Brush pens – everyone’s new favorite
- ⇒ Block Crayons – Waldorf Style



How it works: Watch high-quality, online art videos. I create artwork step-by-step, explaining in detail exactly what I’m doing so students can easily follow along.

Unlimited Questions and Instructor Feedback: Send me photos of your work in progress or ask verbal questions so that I can give you help and encouragement in live time or within one business day depending on when you ask the question. This is possible via Voxer, a free app for the smartphone / iPad. It’s like texting except it’s voice recordings. You can also email me.

Time: Watch videos and draw/color whenever is convenient for you! How much time you spend per week on art is your choice, 30-90 min usually. Easily speed up or slow down videos by adjusting the settings so it’s never too fast or too slow!

Cost: \$300 per semester per student. Art Part 2 will be offered second semester. Students can watch the videos on their computer, iPad, Kindle Fire, or phone. I’ll send you a suggested supply list explaining where to get the best deals for every budget, or use supplies you already have.

Creative Writing



Write and Self-Publish Your Novel or Stories

Class Description: Invent a spellbinding plot and characters as you write and edit your novel or short stories. Design—and illustrate if you wish—a professional, eye-catching cover. Practice grammar in the context of proofreading your book. At the end of this class, show off physical copies of your very own book! **I customize this class to each student 3rd grade - high school.**

When: Watch the videos and complete assignments whenever is convenient for you! This is a year long class.

Unlimited Questions and instructor feedback: I provide feedback on each student's plot and edit up to 1000 words per student. You will have access to online videos you can watch whenever is most convenient for you. Ask questions via email or a free app called Voxer, which is just like texting except it's voice recordings. Depending on when you ask your question, I answer right away or within one business day maximum.

Cost: \$300 per semester per student. I highly recommend you purchase a copy of your student's book, only ~\$2.50 per copy plus shipping. Students can watch the instructional videos on their computer, iPad, Kindle Fire, or phone. Students will have access to free workbooks at their grade level by National Novel Writing Month.

Digital Photography

Learn to Take Stunning, Professional Photos!

Age 9-18. This class covers college-level concepts taught in a way that is easy for a 9 year old to understand. Older / more advanced students will be held to more challenging photography standards.

Class Description: Take amazing photos with your smartphone, digital camera, or D-SLR! Create an online portfolio with your best images. Participate in fun photo challenges to practice key skills! In addition to foundational skills like composition, students can request special topics such as posing people, architecture, night, or food photography, etc.!

Cost: \$300 per semester per student. Requires a camera or smartphone. Students can watch the videos on their computer, iPad, Kindle Fire, or smartphone. Photography Class Part 2 will be offered second semester.

Time: Videos are detailed, yet as short as possible so that you can spend your time actually taking photos. Easily speed up or slow down the videos by adjusting the settings so it's never too fast or too slow! Turn in one photo per week as homework.

Unlimited Questions and Feedback: You will have access to online videos you can watch whenever is most convenient for you. I personally critique 14 photos per student, providing detailed feedback. Ask questions via email or a free app called Voxer, which is exactly like texting except it's voice recordings. Depending on when you ask your question, I answer immediately or within one business day maximum.
